

Notice to Park Users

Re: Tree Removal Related to Stabilization of the Slope Failure on Parkside Drive, South of Indian Valley Crescent

The City of Toronto is undertaking a slope stabilization project along the west side of Parkside Drive south of Indian Valley Crescent in response to the recent slope failure. A Certified Arborist has completed an assessment of the proposed project. The trees in the failure area have been identified for removal and will be removed in the following days. The trees on the perimeter of the construction site will be protected according to the City's Tree Protection Policy.

The attached map identifies the area affected by this work.

Some removed trees and woody debris may be left in the natural area to provide for wildlife habitat.

Following the completion of the slope stabilization, the site will be protected with erosion control blankets and seeded with a mix of native wildflower and grasses. In spring, the site will be planted with trees and shrubs native to High Park.
